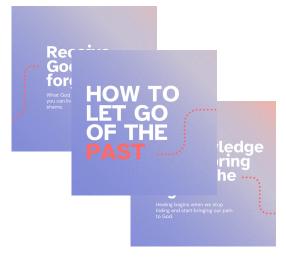

When — Any day of the week

How — Clip from the sermon as a reel, a
shareable quote graphic, photos from worship
or lobby moments, or a short selfie-style recap
from your pastor.

# **Suggested Captions:**

Last week, (Lead pastor name) talked about why we need to surrender to God — and how to do it — some tough lessons to learn! What was one thing you underlined in your notes?

Sunday's message hit home! (Pastor's name) reminded us that trusting God isn't always easy, but it's always worth it. What's one truth you've been holding onto this week?



## Weekend Service Invite

# **Primary Goal:**

The goal is not, "Hey come to our service;" the goal is to make your audience feel like they're already part of the story before they even walk through the doors.

## **Secondary Goal:**

Make it easy for people to say, "yes" to coming by giving clear service times & locations, and a friendly nudge.

#### Method:

When — Either Friday or Saturday
How — Photo or video (people at your church or
pastor in their office prepping the sermon)

# Suggested Caption: (sermon prep)

Getting ready for Sunday (Pastor's name) has been praying and preparing a message all about finding peace when life feels uncertain. We can't wait to share it with you. Join us this weekend!

Secondary Caption Info: (people at church)
From the moment you walk through the doors,
you're family. We can't wait to see you (and
your kiddos!) this Sunday. Here's when we meet:

# **Next Steps**

### **Primary Goal:**

Encourage your people to take the next step in their faith and/or the next step to get plugged in at your church: Attend a Welcome Party, Get Baptized, Join a Small Group, Join a Ministry Team, Sign up to Serve at an Outreach Event

#### Method:

How — Always through storytelling: short quotes, video snippets, or photos from real people — not slides with info.

Suggested Caption: (Welcome Party)

Wondering what your next step could be? Start with the Welcome Party! It's a simple, relaxed way to connect, ask questions, and find out what we're all about. We'd love to see you there!

# Suggested Caption: (Baptism)

Ready to take your faith public? We Baptism is an outward sign of the inward change Jesus brings. If you're ready, or just curious, let's talk! We'd love to help you take your next step.



# Volunteer Highlight

### **Primary Goal:**

Celebrate your volunteers and show how service is both meaningful and joyful.

### **Secondary Goal:**

What gets celebrated gets repeated. Recruit volunteers by showing that it's easy and fun to volunteer at your church. Warning, this should be very subtle. You are not begging people to volunteer. Let others see the culture of serving, not by recruiting, but by honoring.

#### Method:

Photo of volunteers in action.

## Suggested Caption:

Meet [Name], the one making sure every lyric, light, and sound comes together seamlessly each Sunday. You might not always see them on stage, but you definitely feel their impact. Thanks for using your gifts to help people experience worship in a powerful way!

## **Secondary Caption Info:**

# **NOVEMBER - WHO DID JESUS DIE FOR?**

#### Social Post #2

#### Who Did Jesus Die For Reel

Film a short, simple reel with a single chair and the text on screen: "Who did Jesus die for?"

Then cut between clips of different people from your church sitting in the chair—kids, teens, parents, seniors, volunteers, pastors—everyone. End with text that says, "For all of us." This visual reminder of the Gospel message helps your audience feel seen and invites them to reflect on the power of Jesus' sacrifice. Click here to watch the video example.

#### **CAPTION EXAMPLES**

Teaser: Jesus died for you.

Take a moment to reflect—when did that truth first become real in your life?

Engagement: Every face in this video represents a life changed by Jesus. What does His sacrifice mean to you personally?

Inspiration: "But God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us." Romans 5:8
This video is a reminder that Jesus died for every single person, no matter their story, their past, or their struggle. His grace covers all.

- When you think of Jesus dying for everyone, who comes to mind that you're praying for?
- How can our church continue sharing this message in our community?
- What does that truth mean to you personally?
- When did that become real to you in your own story?

# **NOVEMBER - THESSALONIANS SKY REEL**

#### Social Post #3

### 1 Thessalonians Sky Reel

Film a peaceful video of the sky. Soft clouds moving, a sunrise, or sunset, and overlay the text: "Rejoice always, pray without ceasing, give thanks in all circumstances, for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you." 1 Thessalonians 5:16-18." This simple reel reminds people to pause, breathe, and reflect on gratitude and prayer, especially fitting for November. If you don't have time to film a reel, you could make this is a still graphic. Click here to watch the video example.

#### **CAPTION EXAMPLES**

Teaser: Sometimes you just need a moment to look up.

We filmed this moment to help you slow down and remember what matters most joy, prayer, and gratitude. You can find all three in Jesus.

Engagement: We love this verse because it's a reminder that joy, prayer, and gratitude can exist even in hard seasons. Which of these three is hardest for you to practice right now?

Inspiration: Even when life feels heavy, God invites us into joy, constant conversation, and gratitude. These are not small things; they're the foundation of a heart that trusts Him.

- Scripture-centered

- Do you have a favorite way to practice gratitude in your daily routine?
- What helps you stay prayerful throughout your day?
- How have you seen that verse come alive in your life?

# **NOVEMBER - GRATEFUL REEL**

#### Social Post #4

### What Are You Grateful For Reel

This reel features someone from your church walking around and asking different people, "What are you grateful for?" It's a simple, heartwarming look at how people of all ages express gratitude and recognize God's goodness in their lives. Click here to watch the video example.



Teaser: What are you grateful for?

We handed the mic to one of our youngest church members and asked a big question. The answers might just make you smile today.

Engagement: Gratitude shifts our perspective. When we stop to notice the good things God is doing, joy grows. What's something you're grateful for right now, big or small?

Inspiration: "Give thanks to the Lord, for he is good; his love endures forever." (Psalm 107:1) May we be a people marked by gratitude in every circumstance.



### Why This is a Good Post:

- Gratitude content
- Community and joy

- Love that! What helps you stay thankful even when life gets busy or hard?
- How have you seen God work through that blessing lately?
- It's so fun to see our community share what they're thankful for.
   What's one thing you've seen
   God do in our church that you're grateful for?

# **NOVEMBER - VETERANS DAY**

#### Social Post #5

### Veterans Day - November 11, 2025

This post can be a respectful graphic or a photo of an American flag honoring the men and women who have served in the armed forces. It can include a verse about courage or sacrifice, along with a heartfelt message of gratitude from your church. The tone should be thankful, acknowledging both veterans in your congregation and across the nation.

#### **CAPTION EXAMPLES**

Teaser: Freedom isn't free.

Today, we pause to honor and thank all who have served. We're thankful today and every day they serve with courage and honor.

Engagement: Today we honor those who've served our country. Do you have a veteran in your life you'd like to thank or remember today? Share their name below so we can honor them together.

Inspiration: We thank God for the courage, strength, and service of our veterans. May we honor them well and live with the same spirit of sacrifice. As we reflect on Veterans Day, we're reminded that every act of service points us to the ultimate sacrifice of Jesus, who gave His life for us all.



### Why This is a Good Post:

- Shows gratitude
- Honors community

- What's one thing you've learned from their example of courage or sacrifice?
- It's powerful to see people reflect on service and sacrifice.
   What does this day remind you to be thankful for?
- We're blessed by so many who've served. How has your faith shaped the way you think about gratitude and service?

# **NOVEMBER - PRAY FOR YOUR CHURCH**

#### Social Post #6

### How to Pray For Your Church Carousel

This carousel post guides your church family in praying specifically for the church. Each slide features a prayer focus with a corresponding scripture.

- Pray that the church will preach the Word of God without apology. (2 Tim 4:2)
- Pray that the church would devote itself to prayer. (Col 4:2)
- Pray that the church will boldly share Jesus as the only hope for salvation. (Acts 4:12)
- Pray that the church will worship God in spirit and in truth. (John 4:24)
- Pray that our leaders will serve humbly as godly examples to all. (1 Peter 5:2-3)
- Pray that the church will labor and strive to present everyone mature in Christ. (Col 1:28-29)
- Pray that more workers step up to faithfully serve. (Matt 9:37-38)
- Pray for the growth of the church. (Acts 2:47)

#### **CAPTION EXAMPLES**

*Teaser:* Your prayers matter.

These slides show simple, scripture-based ways to pray for our church, whether you have 1 minute or 10.

Engagement: We all have a role in supporting the church through prayer. Which of these areas do you feel God calling you to focus on right now?

Inspiration: Praying for the church is more than a routine—it's a spiritual act that strengthens the body of Christ, encourages leaders, and impacts the community for eternity.



## Why This is a Good Post:

- Encourages prayer
- Scripture-centered

- How could your prayers in that area impact someone else in the church family?
- What's one way you've noticed God answering prayers for our church recently?
- Which scripture or prayer focus has encouraged you the most to trust God with the church?
- How might you incorporate that prayer into your daily routine this week?

# **NOVEMBER - VOLUNTEER APPRECIATION**

#### Social Post #7

### **Volunteer Appreciation Reel**

This reel features the pastor walking around the church thanking volunteers in different ministries: kids, tech, hospitality, worship, parking, and more. It's a heartfelt way to celebrate their service and show the congregation the culture of gratitude and encouragement at your church. Click here to watch the video example.

#### **CAPTION EXAMPLES**

*Teaser:* Smiles, gratitude, and a little bit of laughter—

Our volunteers make every Sunday run smoothly, and we couldn't do it without them! We're so grateful for each one of them!

Engagement: Our volunteers show us how serving is both meaningful and joyful. Who inspires you by serving in our church?

# **NOVEMBER - CONVERSATION CARDS**

#### Social Post #8

### **Thanksgiving Table Conversation Starters**

This post features a carousel graphic with fun, meaningful, and faith-focused questions to spark conversation around your Thanksgiving table. The questions are designed to help families and friends connect, laugh, and reflect on God's work in their lives during the holiday season. Examples:

- What is the best gift you've ever received?
- If you could pick any age to stay forever, how old would you be?
- What is your greatest strength?
- What's your favorite song to sing in the shower?

## Why This is a Good Post:

- Builds community
- Celebrates gratitude

- How do you keep that gratitude in your heart throughout the year?
- How has God shown His faithfulness in that area of your life?

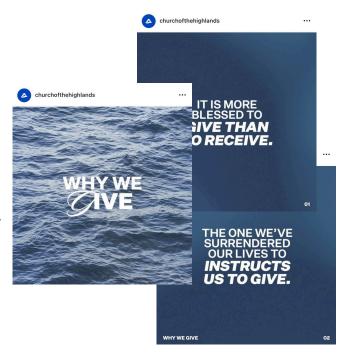

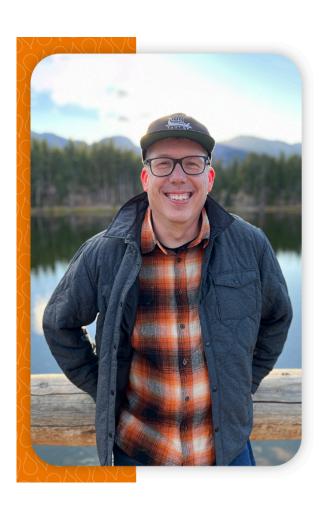

# YOUR BIGGEST CHALLENGES

### **Challenge 1: Content**

"We have a hard time keeping everything current and not just advertising what is happening at our church."

### **Quick Tip from John-Erik:**

"Make sure that Social Media doesn't become just one more channel to communicate everything on. Instead, if you have to communicate what is happening at your church pick one "single" source of truth like Facebook, a Facebook Group, a bulletin. Then highlight big things on social in a way that promotes community."

## **Challenge 2: Engagement**

"We don't have enough engagement. Even from church members."

# Quick Tip from John-Erik:

First question, does your staff engage? It starts with leadership. We have to model the behavior we want to see before we ask others to do it. Staff and pastors should lead the way in this.

Secondly, you have to invest in engagement before it becomes consistent. We often try to have immediate change. It may take up to 90 days before you see more engagement when you've made the shift to make your Social Media more relational.

In that 90 days and beyond, it is important to be consistent in community engagement. It is like tending a garden—nurturing what you want to grow. In Social Media this nurturing looks like responding to and recognizing community contributions. You water what you want to grow. Reward your community for engaging with you!

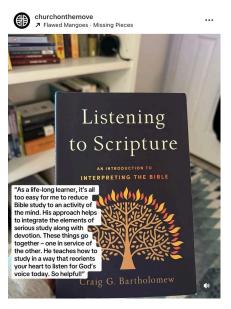

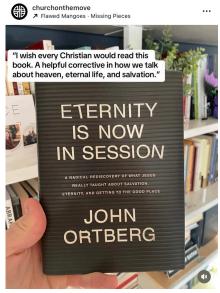

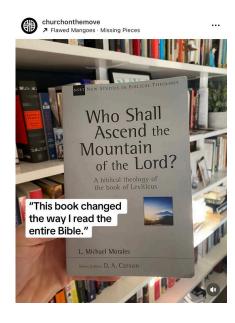
A carousel featuring books that your staff are loving right now. Each slide can include the book cover and a short note about why they recommend it. Great for building community and encouraging personal growth.

- Recognize the reasons you have to be grateful. What has God done, or what is he currently doing, in your life that you need to thank him for?



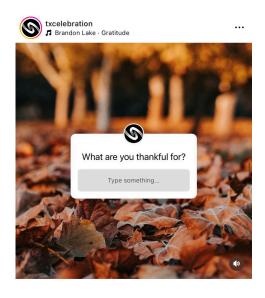




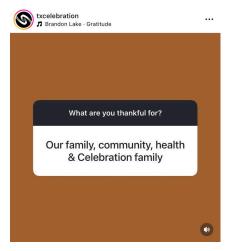

A carousel post sharing answers collected from a story post where you asked, "What are you thankful for?" Highlights real responses from your church family and encourages community reflection and engagement.

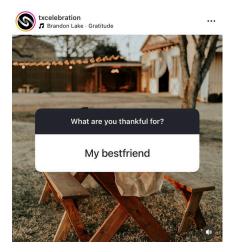












# **Christmas Setup Video**
